



Addison Road Overbridge


Temporary highway reinstatement


May update - 10 queries, 2 complaints



Litter picking at ancient woodland site

- After the winter storms, a significant amount of rubbish from the nearest waste facility flew over to EKFB's site in Sheephouse Wood
- Set by the ancient woodland, the site is where the Bat Mitigation Structure will be constructed
- In total, 14 bags of rubbish were picked by the team, and taken to the nearest compound for safe disposal
