

Utility Trial Holes

What?

- Trial holes will be carried out to confirm existing utility depths in various locations

When and for how long?

- Field works to start mid January and will be carried out during the day
- Highway works to start early December and will be carried out during the day
- Each trial hole will take approximately 1 shift to complete. Some locations may be concurrent




Utility Trial Holes

How (method)?

- Ground Penetration Radar (GPR) surveys will be carried out to establish where utilities are, which is non-intrusive method to locate utilities
- Trial Holes will be delivered through Vacuum Excavation or by Hand
 - Trial holes will typically be 1.5m deep and will range from 0.8m x 0.8m up to 3m x 1m
- Existing utilities will then be recorded through photogrammetry
- Location will then be reinstated
