Introducing Rosefield Solar Farm 18 September 2023



Rosefield Solar Farm

- A proposed new solar farm with battery storage in Buckinghamshire.
- Could power more than 57,000 homes and save around 125,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year.
- Located within Grendon Underwood and Great Brickhill wards.
- Classed as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP).
- The application will be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State (ESNZ) who will make the final decision.





Who is behind Rosefield Solar Farm?


- Rosefield Solar Farm is backed by EDF Renewables and PS Renewables.
- EDF Renewables has an operating portfolio of 41 renewable energy sites in the UK, totalling more than 1.5 GW, and almost 14GW of projects in planning and development including wind, battery and solar.
- PS Renewables has an existing portfolio producing more than 850 MW of renewable energy.
- EDF Renewables and PS Renewables are working closely with the Claydon Estate, the main owner of the land needed for Rosefield Solar Farm, which will play an important role in supporting the estate's vision for a sustainable future.







Location of Rosefield Solar Farm



The plan on this page shows the area we are considering for Rosefield Solar Farm.

We expect to use only around half of the site for energy generation and storage.

We will also be looking for opportunities to boost biodiversity and provide environmental mitigation, such as planting new habitats to support local wildlife.

In other areas, we are working to find the most appropriate locations for the underground cabling that will connect the site to the grid. We will also use some of these areas temporarily during construction.

We will share more information about Rosefield Solar Farm, including our early design, during our consultation which will start on Thursday, 28 September 2023.
