What are we doing?

In mid-March, we will be closing a section of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill to allow National Grid to complete necessary electrical diversions and works ahead of the permanent Gawcott Road realignment later this year. This work is expected to take three weeks to complete.

To carry out these works safely and effectively we will need to close a section of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill with signed diversions. This is for reasons of safety, as our operatives will be working on and around the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

A section of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be closed from Monday 18 March until Sunday 7 April 2024.

There will be no access for Emergency services during this closure.

Moor Sailing Club and the Calvert Jubilee Nature Reserve will be accessed from the South.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control, such as weather. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.



The map below, shows the closure area of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill and the local diversion route from 18 March until 7 April 2024. Access to Great Moor Sailing Club and the Calvert Jubilee Nature Reserve will be accessed from the South. Calvert Road remains closed until Summer 2025.
