High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions about these works, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As part of our preparatory works and for the safety of the public, we have previously closed some Public Rights of Way (PRoWs) in the area near Steeple Claydon.

Where possible, we only close a section of a PRoW, however, there may be instances where will need to close the entire length. PRoWs which are located close to or that cross the construction sites need to be closed and diverted in the interest of safety for all users of these PRoWs.

The sections of the following PRoWS were closed in 2020:

- SCL/9/1
- SCL/9/3
- SCL/7/1
- SCL/7/2

We now need to close and divert a section of PRoW SCL/8/1 as this section of the railway line is being handed over to East West Rail to complete the railway works. Over the next 4 months the new diversion route for the footpath will be formed.

When will these works take place?

A section of the Public Right of Way known as SCL/8/1 will be temporarily closed and diverted from Friday 21 July 2023. The diversion of this PRoW will be signposted.

Duration of works

The closure and diversion of a section of Public Right of Way (PRoW) SCL/8/1 will commence from Friday 21 July 2023.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

The closure and diversion of the Public Right of Way known as SCL/8/1.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

Install and maintain local signs to inform people of temporary closures and diversions.


