What are we doing?

In mid-May 2023, we will be carrying out some work on electric cable installation on Gawcott Road. These works will be completed under 4 way lights.

Following on from these works we will be working on a gas pipe underneath Gawcott Road/Perry Hill which must be disconnected and decommissioned before the bridge can be safely demolished. This is in preparation for the demolition of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill Bridge this summer.

To carry out these works safely and effectively, two sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will require traffic management.

These works are an important step towards the re-alignment of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill over the new bridge, currently under construction.

In order to carry out these works safely and effectively three sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management. This is for safety reasons, as our operatives will be working in open trenches on and around parts of the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

The first section of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management to complete works on electrical cable installation will be Thursday 11 and Friday 12 May.

Following on from these works, a further two sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management from Monday 15 May and Sunday 11 June 2023 near the entrance of the Great Moor Sailing Club and near the entrance of the EKFB West Street Compound to disconnect and decommission the gas pipe.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Duration of works

Three sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management.

Thursday 11 and Friday 12 May, Crossroad of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill and West Street - 4 way traffic lights.

Monday 15 May and Sunday 11 June 2023:

- 3 way traffic lights near the Great Moor Sailing Club and
- 2 way traffic lights near the entrance of the EKFB West Street Compound.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

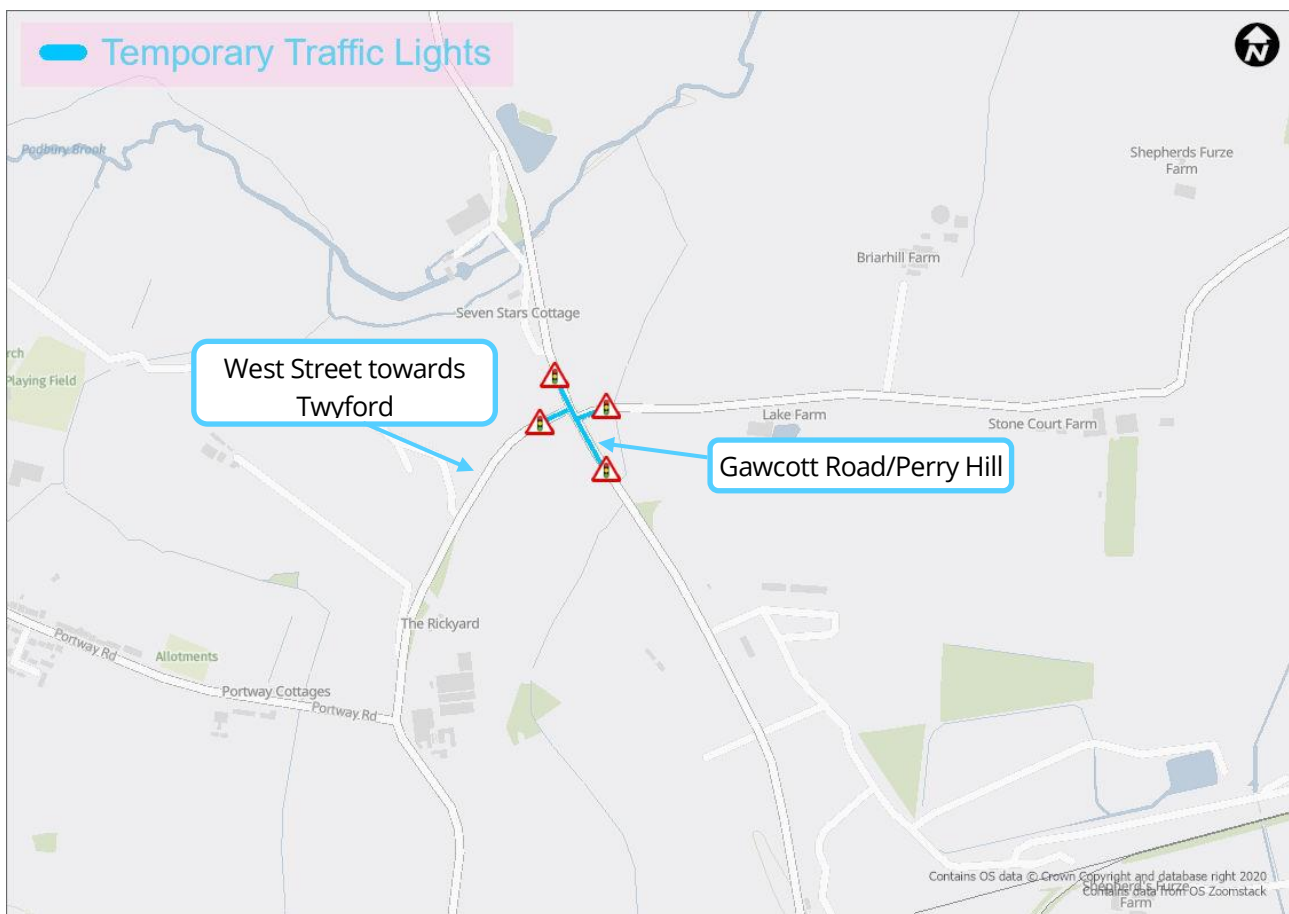

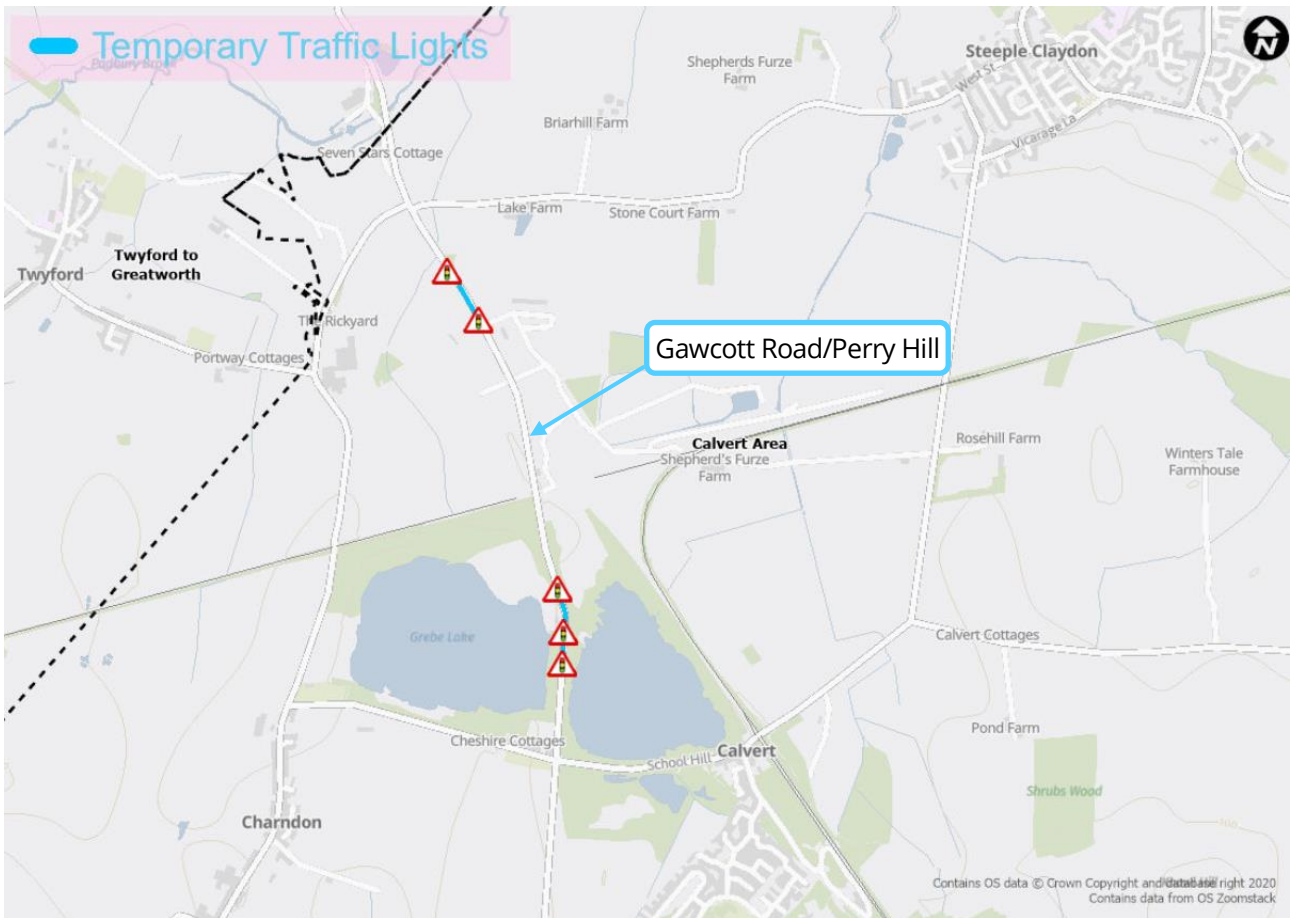


Where will the works take place ?
